HARRISBURG — Over 7,000 people consumed 600 gallons of ice cream in three hours at Ice Cream Sundae Tuesday held on the steps of the Capitol building.

Ice cream lovers stood in line, 25 deep at times, on either side of three dipping booths. Three dippers in each booth scooped a variety of tantalizing flavors while dairy princesses provided topping at two tables that held the tempting final ingredients for a make-your-own sundae.

"Pennsylvania ranks second among the states in ice cream manufacturing and we dairymen are proud of it," Don Duncan, chairman of the sponsoring

Pennsylvania Dairy Promotion Program, stated in explaining the joint ice cream promotion with the Keystone Ice Cream Association. Members of the Ice Cream Association donated the ice cream and toppings for the festival.
