

Regional 4-H Conference set in Delaware

NEWARK, Del. — The Northeast Regional 4-H Volunteer Leader Forum will be held in Wilmington, Del., this year. The event will be held at the Sheraton-Brandywine Inn, Oct. 16 through 19.

Leaders attending the conference will participate in workshops and seminars which will teach them to "Lead the Way" in meeting today's challenges in 4-H. The event, coordinated by 4-H agent Joy Sparks, is being planned and implemented by a group of 4-H leaders.

A main objective of this year's forum is to help leaders develop skills in management and communications. Seminar topics include leadership and directional skills, community and family relations, and ways to make 4-H more visible.

Speakers include Dr. Hope Daugherty and Dr. Thomas Zurcher.

Daugherty is a retired U.S. Department of Agriculture worker and an enthusiastic 4-H volunteer. She has worked with child and family development programs and is interested in keeping 4-H

organizations vital and active.

Zurcher, who is from Minnesota, will use stuffed animals to present a fun and unique way of bringing animal science to all 4-H'ers.

The convention will also provide a place for 4-H leaders to meet each other. "This is a great opportunity to make new friends, interact and develop plans for future 4-H programming," says

Sparks.

The registration deadline is Sept. 10. Sparks encourages participants to register early as a large turnout is expected and hotel space may be limited.


