## USDA Plans Swine Meeting

WASHINGTON — The Secretary of Agriculture's Advisory Committee for Swine Health Protection will meet Wednesday, July 16, in Washington, D.C., to discuss U.S. Department of Agriculture swine health protection program activities and related matters.

The meeting, which is open to the public, will be held in room 3056 of the USDA South Building at 14th and Independence Ave., S.W., from 8:15 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Also on the agenda will be an update on measures being taken to help prevent domestic swine diseases, such as trichinosis and pseudorabies; and a report on the worldwide status of exotic swine diseases.

The committee consists of state and swine industry representatives who meet periodically to give advice on matters affecting swine health. Further information may be obtained from Dr. L. Schnurrenberger, Program Planning Staff, VS-APHIS-USDA, Room 846 Federal Bldg., Hyattsville, Md. 20782.
