The club is a proud supporter of




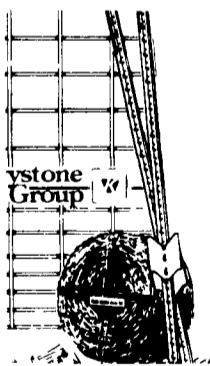
