However, demand narrowed Wednesday and buyers became cautious. As a result fed cattle lost all of early week price advances. rather attractive throughout the week with YG 4's only a minimum problem. Slaughter Cows sold unevenly steady to 1.00 higher, Slaughter Bulls steady. At Wednesday auction Feeder Steers steady to 2.00 higher, advance on offerings over 700 lbs. Feeder Heifers firm to 1.00 higher. Average weight of Slaughter Steers this week 1174 lbs. compared to 1180 lbs. last week and 1248 lbs. year ago. Feeder Cattle numbered 660 head, no cme deliveries this week, 500 cows and buils, balance of supply Slaughter Steers and Heifers.
