Boots and Saddles members who

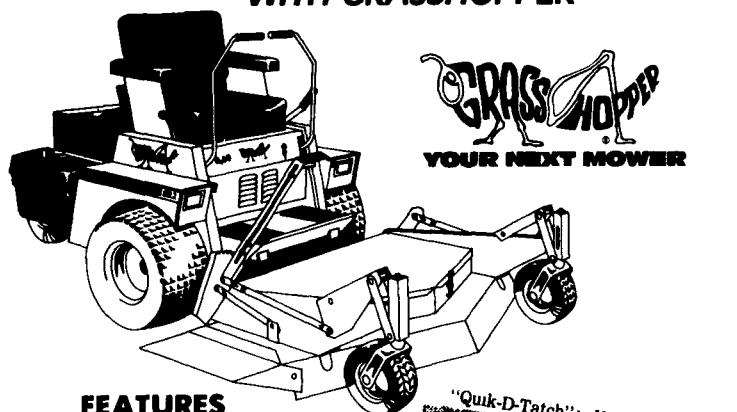

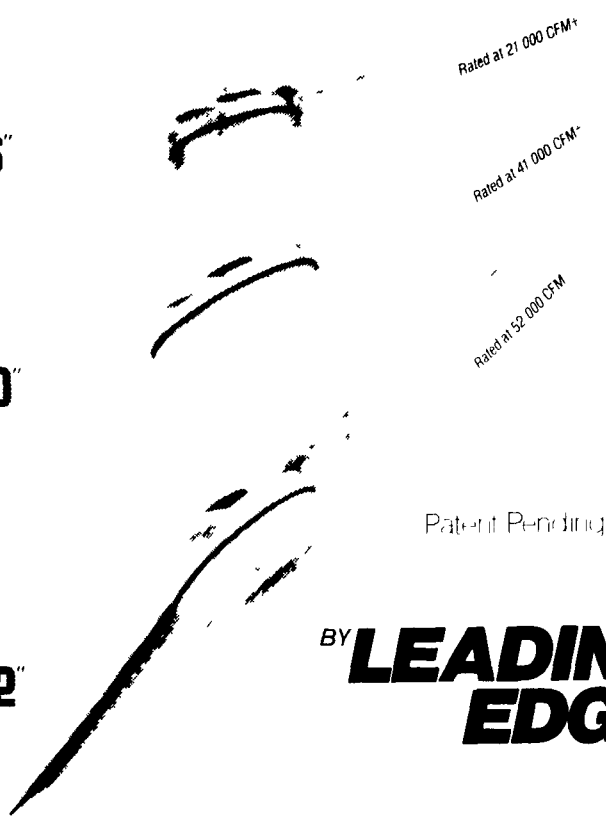
