

Shorthorn Assoc. Honors Eisiminger

OMAHA, Nebr. — Dr. Roger Hunsley, executive secretary-treasurer of the American Shorthorn Association, recently announced that Bradley Eisiminger of Waynesburg, Pa., has been named one of seven national "Builder of the Breed" recipients.

Woodside Farm, owned by Eisiminger, is one of the oldest Shorthorn herds in the country, with its establishment dating back to 1883. Eisiminger is the fourth generation of his family to breed and show Woodside Shorthorns. Together with his wife, Shirley, and son Bret, they are continuing the success story their ancestors began.

Eisiminger exhibits breeding cattle and feeder steers at many county and state fairs, at the Eastern National Livestock Exposition, the Keystone International Livestock Show, the Pennsylvania Farm Show and the State Shorthorn Show. Their senior herd sire, JAF Major Duke 78 X, was a two-time All-American nominee and won reserve calf champion bull honors at the 1979

National Shorthorn Show in Kentucky. He was also the champion bull at the Keystone International and at several state fairs. Another winner for the Eisimingers has been Woodside Cynthia Rose who was champion in the cow and calf class in 1981 and 1982 at the Eastern National.

The firm has been a strong

supporter of Shorthorn sales. Eisiminger helped to organize the Pennsylvania Association Fall Sale, and he is responsible for organizing and hosting the Keystone Autumn Classic Shorthorn Sale each fall at their Woodside Farm. He provides about half of the 40 head of cattle

usually cataloged and invites other breeders from surrounding states to supply the rest of the Shorthorns for the sale.

Eisiminger has been a member of the American Shorthorn Association for 40 years. He is a director of the Mason-Dixon and Pennsylvania Shorthorn Associations, a member of the Maryland Shorthorn Association

and serves on the sale committee in the Eastern Ohio Shorthorn Association.

He helped organize and is currently president of the Greene County Cattlemen's Association, has been a director of the Greene County Fair Board since 1979 and is a member of the Central Greene Vocational Agriculture Advisory Board.

Nominations Due For NY Cattlemen's Direct Marketing Program

CORNING, N.Y. — Nominations for the New York Beef Cattlemen's Association Direct Marketing Program of feeder cattle, both beef and dairy, are due Aug. 18.

Marketing coordinator Lee Kraszewski of Corning said response by producers and potential buyers has been good to date.

The state-wide program has been developed and implemented by the New York Beef Cattlemen's Association to offer producers a marketing alternative that can bring them better prices for their cattle that are preconditioned and that meet grade and eligibility standards. The program is funded

in part by a grant of \$30,000 from the State Department of Ag & Markets. Working with the Cattlemen's Association in the development and implementation are Cornell University and the Department of Ag & Markets.

Peter Nixon of Westfield, president of the Cattlemen's Association, explained the reasons for the development of the program. "Effective and competitive marketing has always been a problem for our New York State beef producers, most of whom are part-time cattlemen with small herds. These producers often lack the time to search out the best marketing alternative and

they lack the number of feeders to attract buyers with competitive prices."

Kraszewski explained that after a producer indicates his interest in direct marketing by nominating his beef or dairy feeder cattle (before Aug. 18) an on-farm evaluation will be scheduled. At the time of the on-farm evaluation the producer will make the actual decision to participate by signing the form committing his feeder cattle. This commitment will include weaning them at least 28 days before the Nov. 8 assembly and required vaccinations.

Feedlot operators will be contacted and will submit bids based

on weight, sex and grade description of the cattle available. The national eight market average prices will be used as the base for all bids, Kraszewski explained.

Several informational meetings have been scheduled to give New York producers more details about this Direct Marketing program. These meetings will be at 7 p.m. Aug. 4 at Wegman's Market meeting room in Corning; at 7 p.m. Aug. 5 at the Country House in Syracuse; at 7 p.m. Aug. 6 at the Genesee County Cooperative Extension Office in Batavia and at 7 p.m. Aug. 7 at the Schoharie County Cooperative Extension office at Cobleskill.
