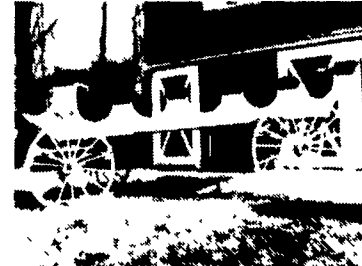

Two auctioneers will be selling simultaneously in order to sell everything accepted for this session starting at 9:30 AM on Thursday.

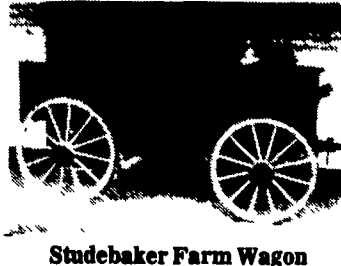

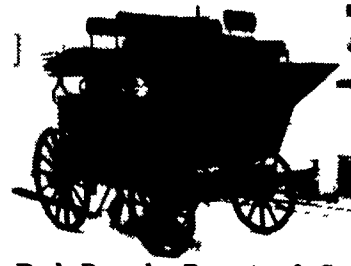


Restored Band Wagon

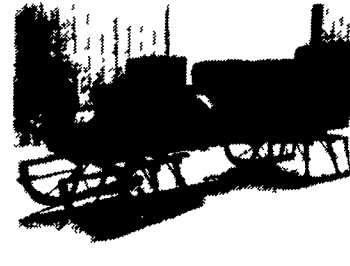
