Compared to Tuesday's 3:30 P.M. report, fresh pork loins 14-18 lbs. 3.00-4.00 higher; 22#up 3.00 higher; Boston Butts 2.00-4.00 higher; skd. hams .75-8.00 lower; fresh sds bellies 12-16 lbs. 4.00-7.50 lower, frozen 14-16 lbs. 3.00-5.00 lower; other cuts generally steady. Trade slow to moderate for light to moderate demand and offerings.

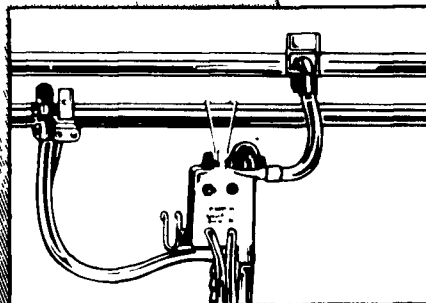
