Eaton, Ga., was sweetened with eligibility for entry into the Super Cow Sweepstakes. The Sweepstakes, widely advertised by the consigners, is a promotional raffle for a chance at another offspring of the great Rilara Mars Las Ravena cow; it will conclude at the 1987 Holiday ET Extravaganza on a cruise ship.

The young Ravena heifer sold for \$7,000 to Shentomac Dairy, Inc., of the James Martin Family, Knoxville, Md. Previously a commercial herd, Martin has been increasing his registered stock. He was impressed by the rich bloodlines of this heifer and plans to flush her for additional offspring.

Her dam is described as a "beautiful Mars Tony daughter" and is classified EX-91 with records to 32,750 pounds of milk and 1,509 pounds of fat. Ravena was purchased by Rainey and the Briarpatch Syndicate at the 1984 South Fork Sale in Texas for \$225,000. Over 100 offspring from this notable cow have sold for a total in excess of \$450,000.

Perkiomen Pollyboots Patty-ET, a yearling Browncroft Jetson daughter, sold for the fourth high price. Consigned by Perkiomen

Partners and Jerry Hall, Millbrook, N.Y., she was purchased by the Holstein Division of Kaolin Mushroom Farms, Inc., Oxford, for the bid of \$5,400. Her dam is an Excellent Bootmaker daughter with records to 35,490 pounds of milk and 1,149 pounds of fat in 365 days.

Coming in fifth in the bidding with a price of \$4,600 was a first choice Ned Boy heifer out of Target-City Tradition Cee C-ET. She was purchased by Daniel Souza, Fresno, Calif., and consigned by the partnership of Bohn, Ceranic, Gilliland, Hoover and Schutz from Warriors Mark.

Referring to the sale line-up, Denny Remsburg of Remsburg Sale Service said, "It's an outstanding group of Chairman and Ned Boy daughter." Forty-two of the 62 select sale consignments were daughters of either Cal-Clark Board Chairman or Whittier-Farms Ned Boy, premier sires of the Sire Power line-up and of the Holstein breed.

The bidding proved Remsburg's statement correct as these daughters commanded the top prices of the day and took the sale average to \$2,898 on the 62 head. Other sires featured were Browncroft Jetson, Sunny-Craft
