

Champion Hogs Bring Record Prices At Franklin Co. 4-H Show, Sale

CHAMBERSBURG — Record prices for show champions were set at the 44th Annual Franklin County 4-H Pig Club Show and Sale held at the Chambersburg Livestock Market, Aug. 7th.

The grand champion, shown by Donna Sheiss, 967 Marion Road,

Chambersburg, was a 250-pound Duroc purchased by W.R. Sellers Livestock of Greencastle for a new record price of \$4.25 per pound.

The reserve champion also established a new record sale price and was shown by Todd Stoner, 7598 Hissong Road, Mercersburg.

The 246-pound animal was purchased by the Greencastle Livestock Market for \$4.05 per pound.

The grand champion pen-of-three, shown by Darren Wilson, 7971 Nyesville Road, Chambersburg, was purchased by Wayne F. Craig & Sons, Orrstown for \$1.17 per pound.

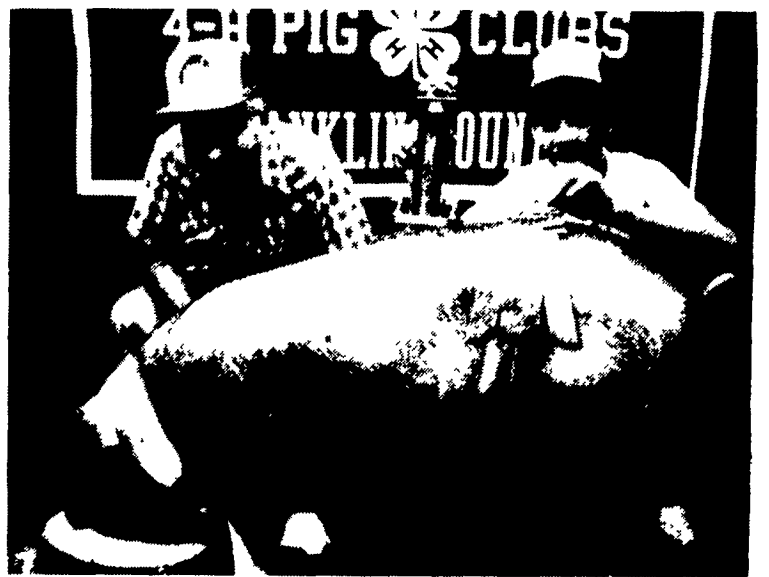
The reserve champion pen-of-three, also shown by Todd Stoner, was purchased by Phares Horst, Hagerstown for \$1 per pound.

Grand champion fitting and showing honors went to Eric Sheiss, while younger brother David Sheiss captured the reserve champion fitting and showing honors.

The sale totaled 15,285 pounds of pork-on-the-hoof that sold for \$15,123. The 67 head averaged 228 pounds and averaged 99 cents per pound with the champions included and 85 cents without champions, to establish one of the very best 4-H Pig Club Sales in recent years.

The show was judged by John Strawbridge, a well-known producer of purebred Hampshire and Yorkshires from R.D. 2, Windsor.

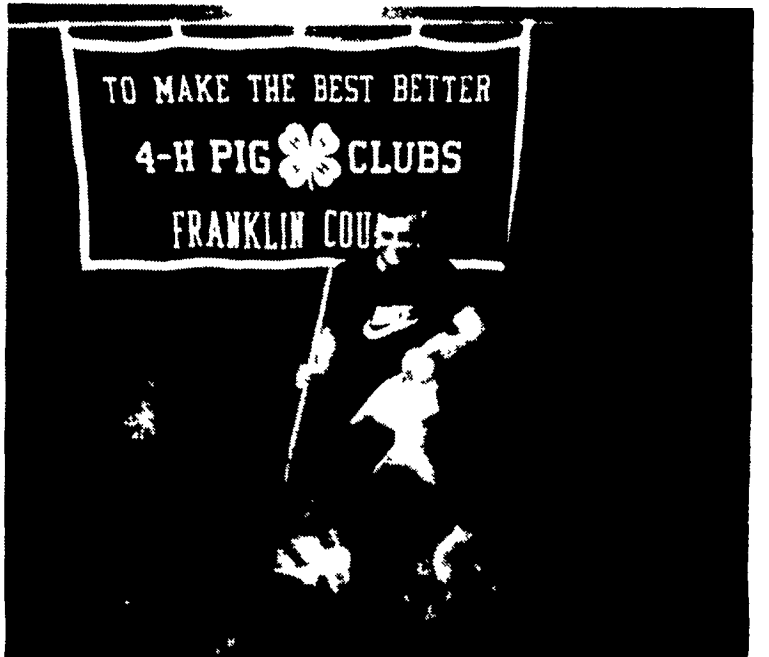

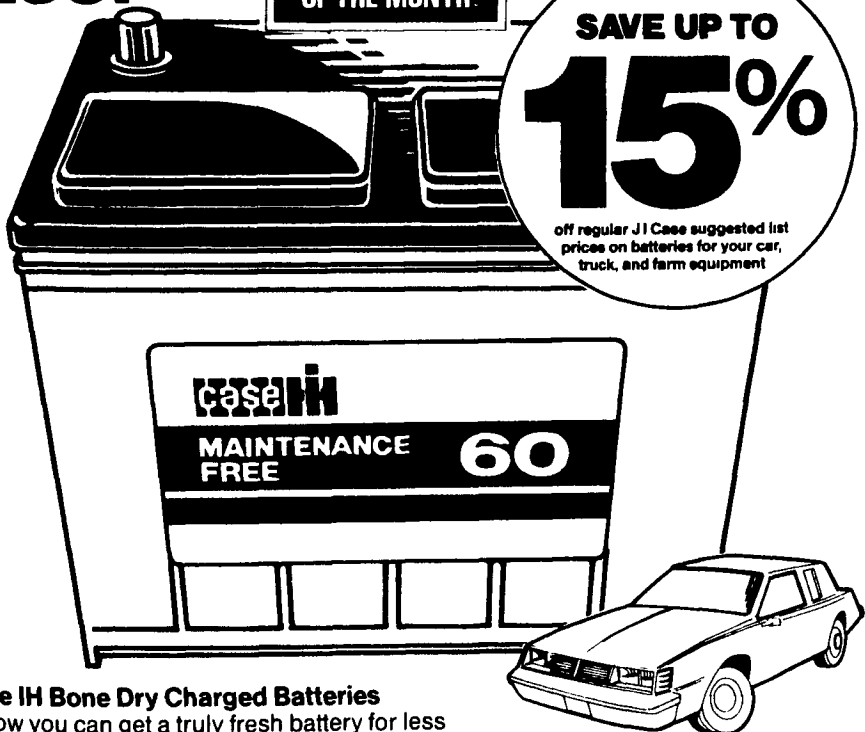

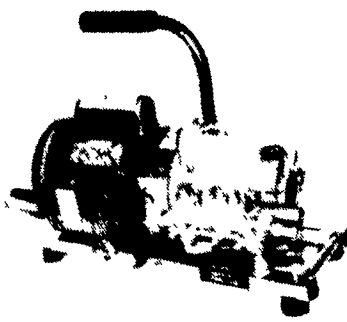
