\$4,900 Tops Kraybill Dispersal

ELVERSON — Two bidders matched each other, dollar for dollar, for the right to own Dimon-Acres Valiant Satin. When the hammer came down for the final time, Mark Weber, Mohnton, was the successful bidder, outpointing contender Wilmer Hostetter. Weber purchased Satin for \$4,900 at the recent Wilmer and Mark Kraybill Herd Dispersal.

Satin, a VG-87 Valiant daughter, will freshen in December with a Whittier Farms Ned Boy calf. During her first lactation, in 300 days, she produced 17,145 pounds of milk and 534 pounds of fat. Her cow index stands at plus 364 milk and plus 13 fat.

Her dam, out of Lawcrest Marvex-Twin, produced a top record of 19,090 pounds of milk in 253 days. The next two dams produced records over 22,000 pounds of milk and 800 pounds of fat.

Kore Peachey, Milroy, purchased the second-high selling animal. Fountain-Farm Jem

Marquis. This 4-year-old cow, classified VG-87 with an excellent mammary, will freshen in September with a Ned Boy calf.

As a 4-year-old, she became the 10th generation to be classified at 87 points or better. Her next four dams produced records over 22,000 pounds of milk.

Her top record stands at 21,460 pounds of milk and 771 pounds of fat. Her present cow index stands at plus 272 milk and plus 23 fat with a CTPI of plus 444.

Traveling from Belvidere, N.J., Oscar Unargst returned home with the third-high selling animal. He purchased Penn-Lite Chairman Lulu for \$2,300. A chairman daughter, she produced a top record of 15,340 pounds of milk and 545 pounds of fat. Bred in November, she will freshen this month with a Den-K Kirk Boy calf.

The sale averaged \$1,048 on 84 head. Dale Hoover managed the sale and read pedigrees. Leon Kurtz handled the auctioneering assignment.

 Plan IV: 7 way clostridial plus IBR and P13 and Haemophilus Somnus and Pasteurella at least 14 days prior to sale and not more than 50 days. Second shot of Haemophilus Somnus and Pasteurella bacterin at least 14 days after first shot.

Health plans II and IV are administered to reduce calf stress from sale to your feedlot. You may need a more complete vaccination program for your wintering program. Please consult your veterinarian.
