Actual loss loans will be available at 5.0 percent interest for the first \$100,000 and 8.0 percent interest for any amount over \$100,000 for eligible farmers who are unable to get the needed credit elsewhere.

The loan ceiling amount will be 80 percent of the actual production loss and 100 percent of the actual physical loss, or \$500,000, whichever is the lesser amount. Loan terms will normally be cheduled for up to 7 years, as


