Slaughter steers and heifers ranged firm to .25 higher for the week. Buyer demand proved generally good and overall finish appeared fairly attractive. Slaughter cows 1.00-3.00 higher, slaughter bulls steady to 1.00 higher.

Estimated 5 day receipts this week 5,900 compared to actuals last week for the holiday shortened week of 3,859 and actuals last year of 7,945. Slaughter steers comprised 43 percent of the week's receipts, slaughter heifers 41 percent, slaughter cows 7 percent and feeder cattle 8 percent.

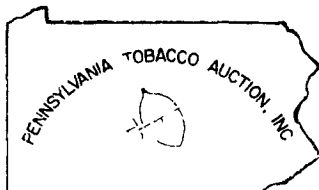

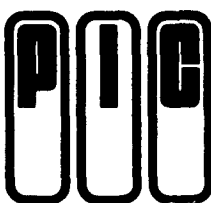
