

Indiana Fair Posts Dairy Champions

INDIANA — On an ordinary summer morning many children of dairy farmers are up at dawn beginning their day's work. Aug. 26 was no different for the 4-H dairy members in Indiana County only this day began much earlier than usual. For this day was the date these 4-Hers would parade their animals at the county fair. The event was the annual junior dairy show held at the Indiana county fairgrounds.

Type judge for the day, Don Koontz, judged a total of 109 head of dairy cattle, while Lori Knepp of Everett judged 29 4-H members on their fitting and showmanship skills.

In the Brown Swiss category Lisa Coleman captured both grand and reserve champion titles. Lisa is a member of the Saltsburg Future Farmers of America.

The Guernsey competition was dominated by southern Indiana 4-H

member Lori Winsheimer, who owned both the grand champion and reserve grand champion females.

Holly Edwards lead her senior 2-year-old Holstein, Dappledale A Susan, to the grand champion position. Holly also exhibited the reserve grand champion female, a Valiant daughter.

A southern 4-H dairy club member, Chris Zagrodnichek, exhibited the grand champion Jersey female. Christopher led a 4-year-old cow to this position. Wendy Allison, a member of the northern 4-H club received the reserve grand champion title.

Amy Brant, a Mount Union, Huntingdon County resident, received the grand champion Milking Shorthorn title with her 3-year-old female. Patrick Zagrodnichek exhibited his junior yearling to the reserve grand champion position.

In the fitting and showing competition Lori chose her champion showman. After much deliberation, Lori Winsheimer stood at the top. This is the second consecutive year that this Guernsey breeder has captured the senior master showman award. Susan Nehrig, also a member of the southern Indiana 4-H dairy club, received top honors in the senior fitting category.

In the junior category Chris Zagrodnichek claimed both master showman and master fitter awards.
