LEESPORT — Each year the Berks County Conservation District holds a Conservation Tour. Other agencies who are co-sponsors this year are the Berks County Agricultural Stabilization

and Conservation Service, Soil Conservation Service, and the Bureau of Forestry.

This year the Bieber Bus will leave the Agricultural Center parking lot at 9 a.m. Thursday,

Oct. 16th.

1986 is "The Year of the Forest" in Pennsylvania, so the tour will highlight activities that tie in with that theme. The first stop will be in Reading at the Georgia Pacific Paper Plant on Riverfront drive for a short tour of the facility. The second stop will be at the largest white oak tree in Pennsylvania, located on the grounds of the Wernersville State Hospital.

A stop will be made at the Keeney-Ziegler Honey Storage Facility just East of Bethel and then a lunch stop at Kauffman's Bar-B-Q Chicken Ranch. The afternoon will feature a short tour of the new sawmill run by J.O. Younker Son's Incorporated and a tour of the Harris Pine Mills furniture plant at Hamburg. The tour

is expected to end at the Ag Center parking lot by 4 p.m.

As always, conservation practices that can be observed, will be pointed out along the way by

personnel who sponsor and conduct the tour.

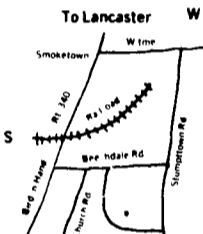

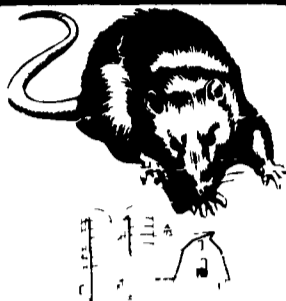
