Virginia Girl Wins

Junior Stockman Award

HARRISBURG - A 15-year-old Virginia girl has won the coveted 1986 Keystone Junior Stockman of the Year award by outscoring 29 other FFA and 4-H competitors in the junior livestock and meats judging contest at the 30th Keystone International Livestock Exposition.

Angela Craun of Mt. Crawford took the title with a 739 point score and a 19 point margin over the second place finisher, Joann Rishel of Seven Valleys, York County, PA.

A teammate of Angela's, David Seekford of McGaheysville, VA, finished third in individual competition with a 702 score. Their team, Spottswood FFA No. 1 of Spottswood High School in Penn Laird, VA, achieved the top overall team score.

In winning the championship, Angela earned herself a trophy and a \$500 Savings Bond. As runner-up, Joann receives a trophy and a \$250 Savings Bond, and David, for running up the third highest score, gets a trophy and a \$100 Savings Bond.

The Spottswood team, finishing first with a 2,083 point tally, receives a \$100 premium. The home team or teams, so to speak, finished second and third. A York County 4-H team comprised of Tim Ferrence of Spring Grove, Lisa Hoover of Mt. Wolf and Melissa Trostle of Red Lion compiled 2,002 points and preserved Pennsylvania's pride. Finishing third with 1,939 points was another York County 4-H team that included Joann Rishel, Kris Miller of York and Susan Eisenhour of Wellsville. The second and third teams receive premiums of \$90 and \$80, respectively.
