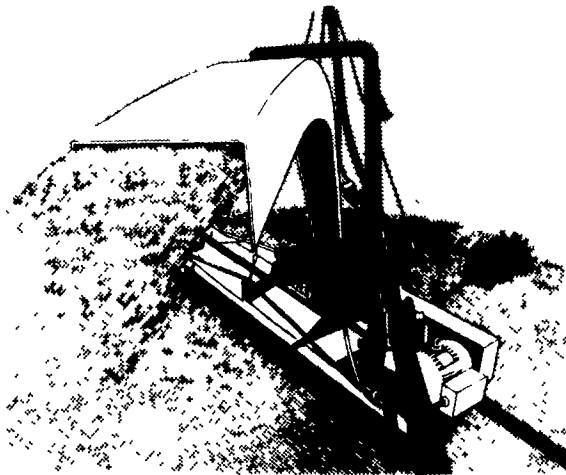

The property was sold for \$156,000 and included valuable timber, old double plank home and a large bank barn.

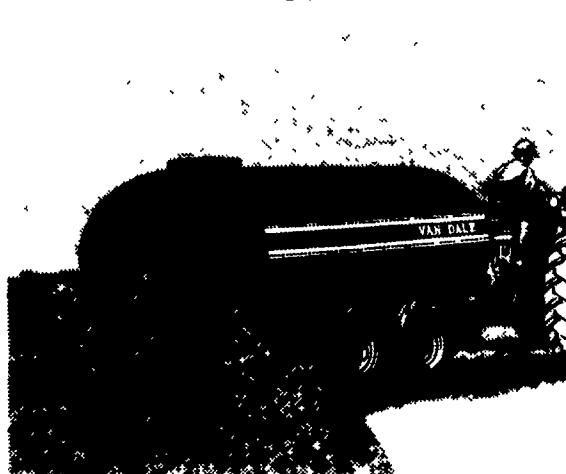

**Performance for tough silo-unloading jobs:**



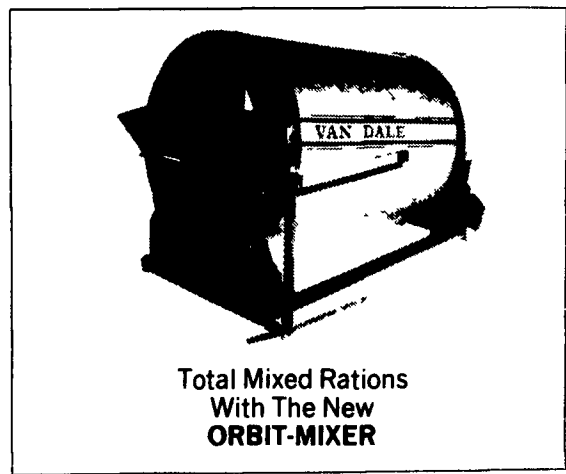
