Homemade Mayonnaise

1 egg

1 teaspoon mustard


1/2 teaspoon sea salt

1 teaspoon raw sugar

3 tablespoons apple cider vinegar or lemon juice

1 cup safflower oil

Mix egg, mustard, salt, sugar, vinegar and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of the oil in blender. Blend until smooth. Continue blending while adding the remainder of the oil. Add oil very slowly in a steady stream into the center of the egg mixture. Store in a jar in the refrigerator. Note: Sea salt is available at health food stores.



ANSWER Judy Barto, Willer et, requested a recipe for green tomato jam using green tomatoes, fruit gelatin and sugar Thanks go to Janice Miller, Milton, for sharing the following recipe.

Green Tomato Jam

4 cups pureed green tomatoes

4 cups sugar

6 ounce package fruit flavored jello

Boil pureed green tomatoes and sugar for 20 minutes Remove from stove and add the package of jello. Let stand 10 minutes. Fill containers and cover with paraffin. If iam is too stiff, 5 cups of tomatoes can be used. My recipe cells for raspberry jello, but different kinds can be tried.

Lemon Cream Cheese Pie

8 ounces cream cheese

2 cups milk

1 small package instant lemon pudding

19-inch crumb crust Stir cream cheese until very soft. Blend in 1/2 cup milk until smooth. Then add 1½ cups milk and pudding. Beat slowly with rotary beater for 1 minute. Pour immediately into a 9-inch crumb crust. Chill
