A cow owned by Charles Irons, Smethport, topped the McKean County DHIA for September with a production of 968 pounds of fat and 23 336 pounds of milk

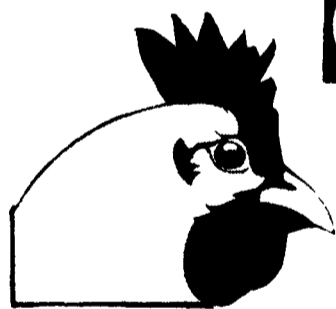

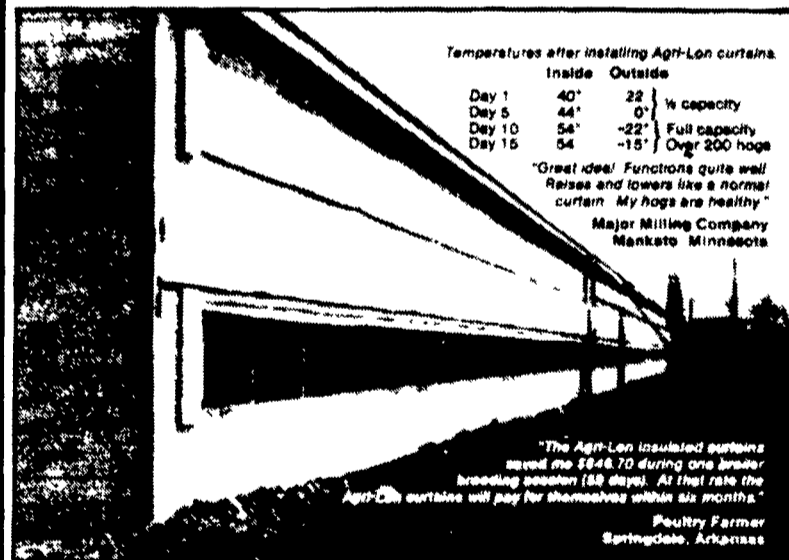

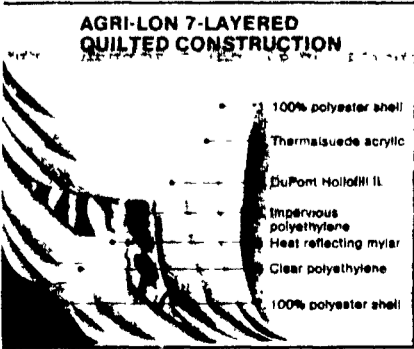
