



"Heifers can present problems for the cattle feeder if they are not managed properly," the veterinarian states. Pregnant heifers are a liability, due to their docking at slaughter and reduced yields, and as a result, feeders to e found spaying to be an alternative."

Feedlot heifer management, including feeding of MGA (melengestrol acetate) to keep heifers from heat cycling, is discussed by a university extension veterinarian and a feedlot manager.
