\$2,700 Bid Tops Nittany Classic Sale Twice

UNIVERSITY PARK — Students in the Penn State Dairy Science Club, with the help of the Pennsylvania Holstein Association, put on their third annual Nittany Lion Fall Classic Sale last week at the Penn State Ag Arena.

Two animals tied for the high selling price of \$2,700.

One of the top sellers, Hunterdon Valiant Hanna-ET, a bred heifer, sold to James High. She is the daughter of S-W-D Valiant and Hunterdon Elevation Horta, EX-92 3E. Hanna will freshen in December with a Whittier-Farms Ned Boy calf.

Her dam produced a top record of 27,120 pounds of milk and 943 pounds of fat. Stonehurst Farm, Strasburg, consigned the sale

topper.

Her-Joy Rorae Pamela, a 7-year-old cow, also sold for \$2,700. Consigned by Roy Hall, Millerstown, she classified VG-88 with a top record of 24,878 pounds of milk and 973 pounds of fat in 365 days. The Elevation daughter will freshen in November to Tri-Day Valiant Gold.

Purchased by Clark and Neil Bowen of Wellsboro, Pamela is out

of a Fond Matt dam.

Barry Hostetter, Oxford, bought Woodbine Tony Ennie-ET for \$2,600, the third high price of the sale. This January 1986 heifer was sired by Marshfield Elevation Tony. Her dam, Woodbine Ivanhoe E Ella, classified VG-85 and is producing her best record to date, 21,649 pounds of milk and 673 pounds of fat in 180 days.

Consigned by Woodbine Farm

Airville, this heifer traces back to Northcroft Ella Elevation, the all-time All American. Classified EX-97 4E, Ella now has a lifetime record over 200,000 pounds of milk.

The Bowen also bought the next highest selling animal, L and J Electra Deidra, for \$2,400. Consigned by Leroy and Ida Jane Plance, Wellsboro, this 3-year-old daughter of Thonyma Electra classified VG-85 with a Very Good mammary system.

Deidra's first record registered 24,540 pounds of milk and 839 pounds of fat. Fresh on July 21, she produced 93 pounds of milk on her second test. Her index stands at plus 655 milk, plus 12 fat and plus \$59.

Her dam, Ravern Elevation Dutch, classified VG-88 with three records over 20,000 pounds of milk.

The Pennsylvania Holstein Association and the Penn State Dairy Club students made selections for the sale.

Fifty-one head were auctioned for a sale average of \$1,425. Gross volume was \$74,225.

Michael Weimer and Harry Bachman were the auctioneers. Horace Backus read the pedigrees.
