Featured speaker Rev. Glenn Sell of the East Petersburg Mennonite Church encouraged the women to make laughter and joy an important part of their lives.

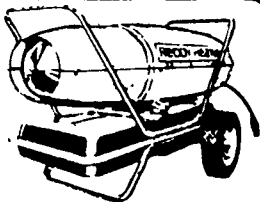

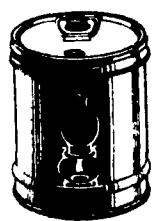

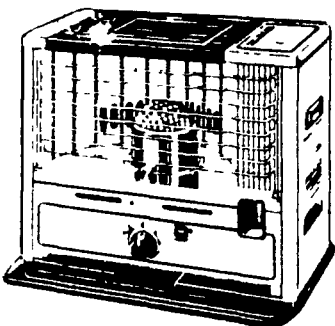
