herds in the county average 17,418 pounds of milk and 621 pounds of fat.

Robert Kindig, president of Pennsylvania DHIA, noted the past year was positive on the state level. "We put enough cows on test

from January to April to offset all the cows lost through the buyout program in the state," he said. Although there are less herds in the state, there are more cows per herd.

A bright spot for the state

association has been a half day drop in turn-around time, the time from when a herd is tested to when the report is in the mail. The average time is now 4.43 days, Kindig noted. He added the turn-around time is still higher than association likes but measures are being taken to improve the time.

Pennsylvania will host the National DHIA Convention in March 1987. A biotechnological conference will be held in conjunction with the convention.

Kindig said the conference is aimed at dairymen in Southeast Pennsylvania and the surrounding states and encouraged dairymen to visit the display.

The association will be increasing fees to increase revenues, Kenneth Sellers, Lebanon County DHIA president, reported. The increase is needed to pay for actual herd testing instead of averaging when supervisors went on vacation. The county adopted this policy two years ago.

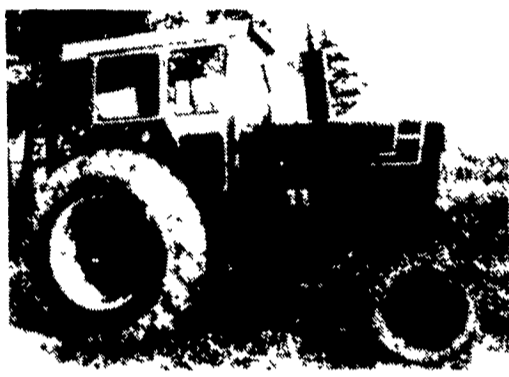

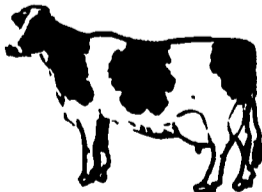
