Mr. and Mrs. George Smith of Smith's Implement, Mercersburg, received a plaque for 15 continuous years of sponsoring the beef club's sale.

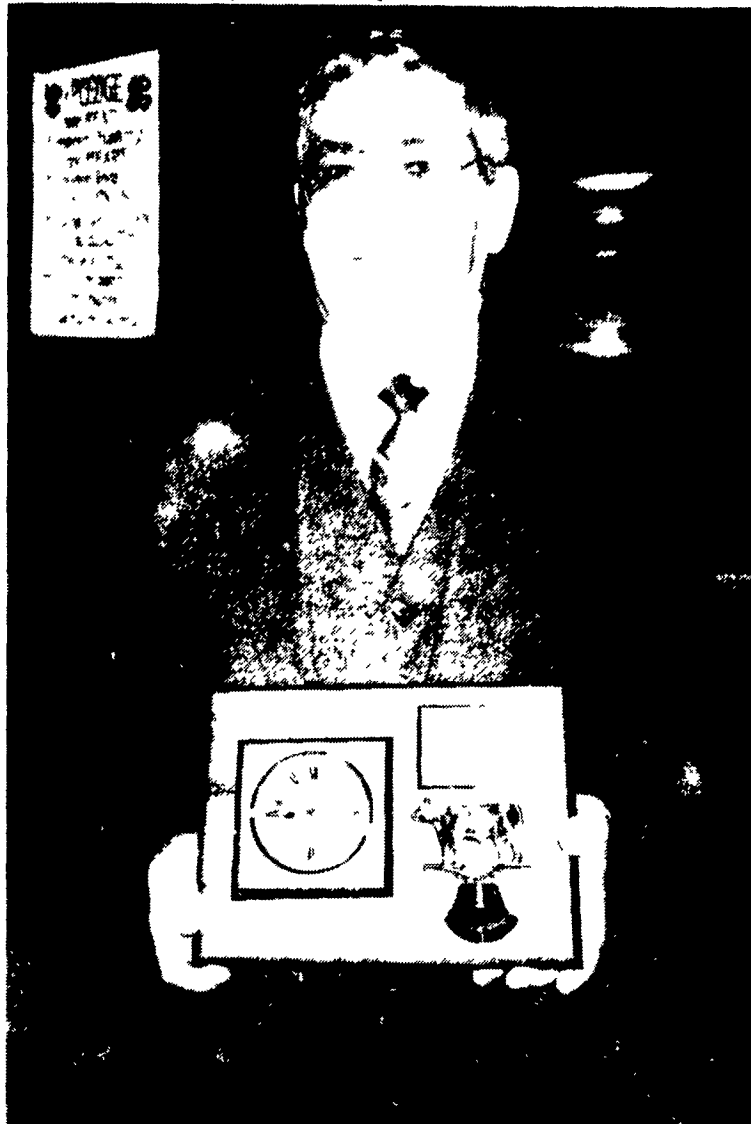

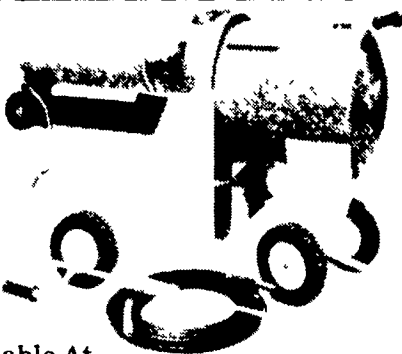
Franklin County Extension agent William Reagan received a custom-made cane for his support of the county 4-H beef club.
