Flowering plants in particular have been more carefully developed to make them longer lasting. Plant scientists and breeders have combined their

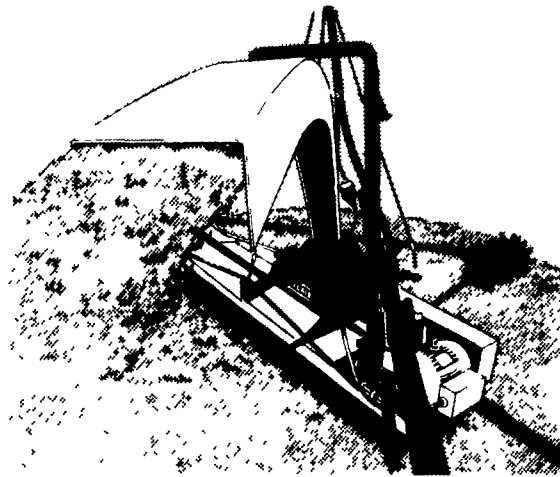
talents to produce plants with excellent floral mileage. Many have superb flower life which lasts for weeks if given some timely attention in the home or office.

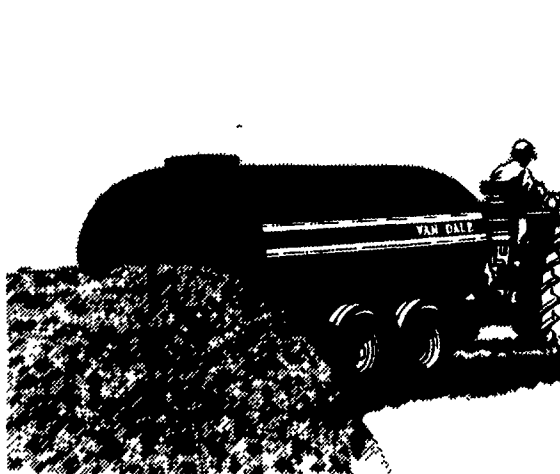

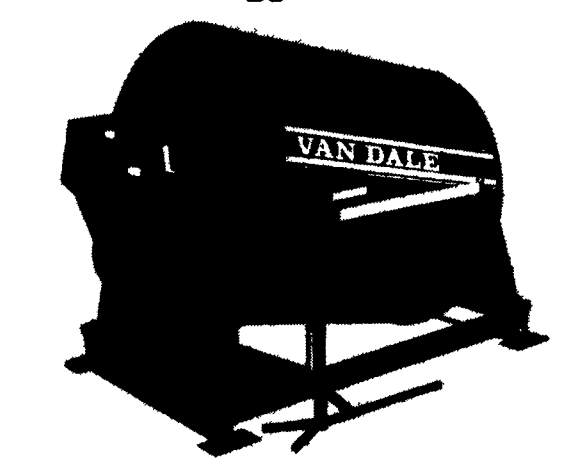

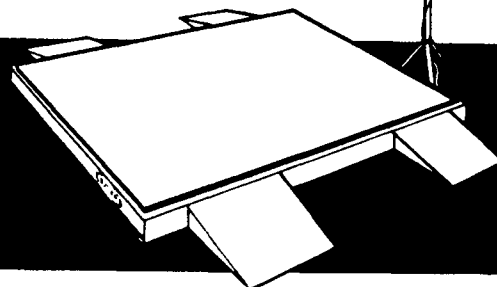
