It also earned 1st and 2nd place non-irrigated in Massachusetts; 1st place in Maryland's no-till irrigated class, plus 2nd place in irrigated, non-till irrigated and no-till non-irrigated; and 2nd and 3rd place no-till nonirrigated in New Jersey.
