Jordan Receives Heifer Project Animals



Children of impoverished families in rural areas of Jordan now have the life-giving nutrition of milk to help them grow up healthy and strong, thanks to Heifer Project International, a U.S. based, non-profit agricultural development agency. Heifer Project has been saving cattle scheduled for slaughter under the federally sponsored Dairy Termination Program and shipping the cows to areas where milk is not normally available.


Fifty cows were shipped to Jordan in May and another 100 cows are scheduled to be sent in 1987 to help low-income families provide food for their children. An American dairy cow can produce up to five gallons of milk a day for hungry families. Heifer Project has already shipped 891 cattle from the Dairy Termination Program to Mexico. Honduras and Jordan. Another 200 are scheduled to be sent to Mexico in December. Shipments to Egypt, Bolivia, Jordan and Mexico are scheduled for 1987.
