**Sale Reports**

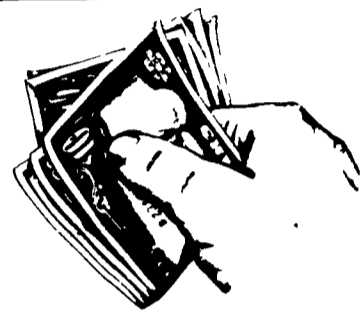

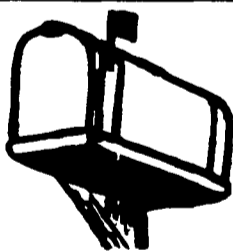
