winning high school vocationalagricultural exhibits. Lower Dauphin Senior High School in Dauphin County took first place honors with an exhibit on the problems of trash disposal and possible solutions. Featuring a model barn separated from city buildings by a mound of trash, it explained that valuable farm land could be forced into use as landfills in the near future and offered solutions such as trash incineration and recycling.

Tri Valley High School from Schuylkill County placed second with an exhibit titled "Computers the Farmer's New Hired Hand." The students backed up a variety of computer components with panels naming some of the uses of the computer on the farm gathering information from networks, budgeting, and keeping financial and production records.






