Cumberland County Executive Board

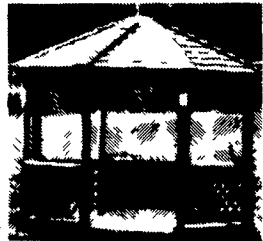
The Cumberland County Executive Board met Feb. 2 at the county Extension office in Carlisle. President Mary Weir presided over a meeting attended by 26 members.

Members answered roll call by stating how the Bible helps them in living their daily lives.

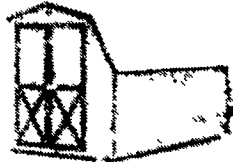
Each of the 23 group presidents received an award for 100 percent
