## Videotape Explains **Manure Calibration**



"How to Calibrate a Manure Spreader" is an eight-minute videotape produced in support of Pennsylvania's Chesapeake Bay Program. 
The videotape is a companion to the "Manure Spreader Calibration Worksheet," a fact sheet produced by the Chesapeake Bay Program's technical note series.
