FEEDER CATTLE IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS AND THE MIDWEST WERE WEAK TO \$2.00 LOWER AS SLAUGHTER CATTLE RANGED STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER IN RESPONSE TO A LOWER BEEF CARCASS MARKET THAT MOVED STEADY TO \$4.00 LOWER COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS FOLLOWED MIDWEST COW AND COW BEEF PRICES STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER THE BOXED BEEF CUT-OUT VALUE OF CHOICE 23 550-700 LB CARCASSES REACHED \$98.06/CWT TUESDAY THIS WAS 9 CENT LOWER THAN LAST WEEK BEEF PRODUCTION LAST WEEK WAS UNCHANGED FROM THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 4 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO WHEN AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE ONLY 2 LB HEAVIER VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS MOVED STEADY TO \$3.00 HIGHER BEFORE TURNING LOWER ALONG WITH EAST COAST CARCASS PRICES SLAUGHTER LAST WEEK WAS 2 PERCENT ABOVE THE PREVIOUS WEEK BUT 3 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO AS AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE ONLY 1 LB HEAVIER THAN IN 1986 LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS AND THE MIDWEST WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER FOLLOWING EAST COAST CARCASS PRICES THAT WERE STEADY TO \$5.00 LOWER SLAUGHTER WAS UP 4 PERCENT FROM THE PREVIOUS WEEK BUT 8 PERCENT BELOW LAST YEAR WHEN AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE 1 LB LIGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS AND THE MIDWEST WERE UNEVENLY STEADY (75 CENT LOWER TO 1.50 HIGHER) PORK PRODUCT PRICES WERE UNEVENLY STEADY TO \$4.00 LOWER EXCEPT FOR LOINS STEADY TO \$6.00 HIGHER OTHER CUTS SHOWED SOME SHORT RANGE STRENGTH FRIDAY PORK PRODUCTION WAS 4 PERCENT BELOW THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 1 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO AS AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE 7 LB HEAVIER THERE IS NO RICHMOND HOG MARKET THE SOUTHEAST VIRGINIA HOG MARKET CLOSED 50 CENT LOWER THAN LAST WEDNESDAY WITH BARROWS AND GILTS 14 220-250 LBS AT \$48.50-49.50/CWT
