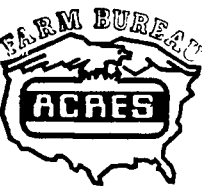

ACRES CORN UPDATE: Corn futures closed higher across the board in good support by commercial buying. The corn basis was mixed and movement continues very light in the country. Deliveries of 1.8 million bushels brings us up to February 25th. Commercials stopped all of the deliveries which leaves the market in a very good overall tone.

ACRES SOYBEAN UPDATE: Soybean futures closed over 3

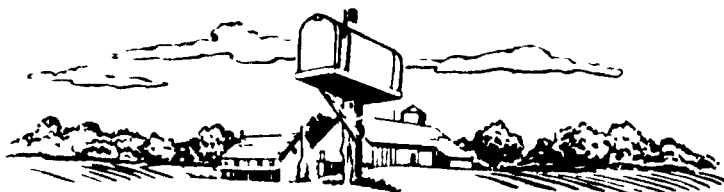
cents higher across the board today. Farmer selling picked up slightly this week, with expectations of loan redemption increasing. The market traded on both sides of yesterday's close. Yesterday and today appear to be a short covering rally with surprising good follow through.

ACRES CATTLE UPDATE: Cattle futures closed sharply lower, touching limit down in the April live cattle futures. There

were several discouraging ideas passed around the cattle pit today. Results of a study on salmonella were to be released today. This stimulated concerns causing the meats to have a very weak undertone. Yield grade #3 choice steers printed \$38.00 to \$39.00 at noon, a drop of \$3.00 to \$4.00 from yesterday.

ACRES HOG UPDATE: Hog futures closed higher and pork belly futures closed sharply higher boosted by late commercial buying. The overall buying was attributed to ideas supplies will remain tight coming into the April/May time frame.

Estimated slaughter today was 290,000 compared with 305,000 yesterday.
