During the month there were 106 herds with 6 162 cows processed in the DHIA program according to Alan P. Kozak county agent. Production ranged from a high of 68 8 pounds of milk testing 3 9 percent fat to a low of 23 0 pounds of milk testing 4 9 percent fat.

In the owner sampler program there were 16 herds with 596 cows being processed. The herds ranged from a high of 62 4 pounds of milk testing 3 4 percent fat to a low of 27 5 pounds of milk testing 3 2 percent fat.

The 10 high individual cow actual production records in DHIA produced on a two times a day milking in 305 days or less (unless otherwise indicated) were in the following herds:

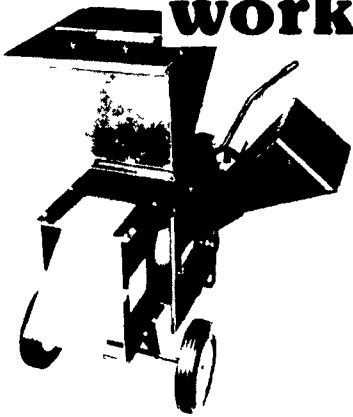

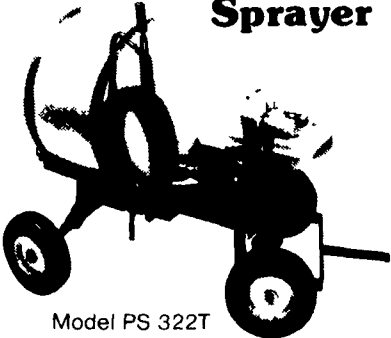
