Grazing Seminar Scheduled

RED LION — A Red Lion-area supplier of fencing and related supplies will be holding a rotational grazing seminar on Thursday, March 26. Seminar host Scott Taylor notes that the focus of the meeting will be on getting the most from your pastures through rotational grazing utilizing Gallagher spring-tight high tensile power fence systems.
 Keynote speaker for the program will be Henry Swayze, a Vermont-based sheep breeder who has experience in applying New Zealand fencing techniques to dairy, beef and sheep operations.
 The program begins at 10 a.m. with a discussion of dairy fencing techniques. After lunch Swayze will discuss rotational grazing systems for beef and sheep producers. The program, including lunch, will be provided free of charge.
 The event will be held at Taylor's residence. Take Route 24 south through Red Lion, and turn right onto Franklin St. Extended. Turn left on Camp Rd. and watch for the sign indicating spring-tight power fence systems. Those planning to stay for lunch should call Taylor at 717-246-2029.
