**FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER AS WERE PRICES IN THE MIDWEST SLAUGHTER CATTLE WERE UNEVENLY STEADY AS THE CARCASS BEEF PRICES REMAINED UNCHANGED COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS AND THE MIDWEST WERE UNEVENLY STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER AS COW BEEF RANGED STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER THE BOXED BEEF CUT-OUT VALUE OF CHOICE 2-3, 550-700 LB CARCASS REACHED \$96.28/CWT TUESDAY THIS WAS 1 CENT HIGHER THAN LAST WEEK BEEF PRODUCTION LAST WEEK WAS 5 PERCENT BELOW THE PREVIOUS WEEK BUT 1 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO WHILE AVERAGE LIVE WEIGHTS WERE 16 LBS**

**LIGHTER VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS FOLLOWED EAST COAST CARCASS PRICES UNEVENLY STEADY SLAUGHTER LAST WEEK WAS 1 PERCENT BELOW THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 15 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO, HOWEVER AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE 2 LBS HEAVIER. LAMB PRICES AT VIRGINIA AUCTIONS HELD STEADY ALONG WITH MIDWEST PRICES AS EAST COAST CARCASS PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER LAST WEEK'S SLAUGHTER WAS DOWN 1 PERCENT FROM THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 20 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO WITH AVERAGE WEIGHTS ONLY 1 LB LIGHTER. HOG PRICES AT VIRGINIA AUCTIONS AND THE MIDWEST RANGED STEADY TO \$1.50 HIGHER AS MOST PORK PRODUCTS MOVED HIGHER LOINS WERE STEADY TO \$3.50 HIGHER HAMS UP TO \$4.00 HIGHER AND BELLIES STEADY TO \$2.00 HIGHER PORK PRODUCTION LAST WEEK MOVED 1 PERCENT ABOVE THE PREVIOUS WEEK, BUT WAS 3 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO WHEN AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE 5 LBS LIGHTER THE RICHMOND HOG MARKET CLOSED STEADY TO 50 CENT HIGHER THAN LAST WEDNESDAY WITH BARROWS AND GILTS 1-4, 220-250 AT \$46.00-47.00/CWT.
