'HARRÎSBURG – Department of Agriculture has accepted 19,665 more acres on 458 Pennsylvania farms to be set aside under the Conservation Reserve Program, according to Eugene Thompson of the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service.

Land entered into the Con-

servation Reserve, as directed by the Food Security Act of 1985, will be ineligible for farming for 10 years and must be planted with permanent vegetative cover.

Participants will receive cost share payments of up to 50 percent of eligible costs to establish trees and grass on acreage placed in the reserve. These payments will partially reimburse farmers for

the one-time costs of establishing required conservation practices on the cropland.

Producers designated 1.9 million acres of corn base acreage to take advantage of a corn "bonus" rental payment that was offered to entice highly crodible land into the Conservation Reserve. The bonus, to be paid in generic commodity certificates, amounts to \$2 a bushel, based on the ASCS

program payment yield for cor for each acre of corn base accept into the Reserve.

Farmland signed up to dat totals 19,488,587 nationally, 36,00 acres in Pennsylvania. Thompso stated that these figures are acre for which bids were accepted.
