Maryland Tobacco

Week Ending March 24

Maryland's tobacco auction season opened March 24 and will continue to late April. Prices shown reflect six sale days at eight auction houses in southern Maryland. Demand has been strong for bright Type 32 tobacco, with foreign buyers offering \$1.60 to \$1.75 per pound. Market for middle grades has been very soft, and virtually no market exists for dulls and tips.

Bill Would Exempt Horsedrawn Vehicles

A bill which would exempt horsedrawn vehicles from having to use flashing signal lights during daylight hours has been unanimously passed by the Senate, according to Sen. Noah Wenger, R-36, the bill's prime sponsor.

Current law requires all vehicles which are equipped with simultaneous flashing lights to have these signals in operation when the vehicle is unable to maintain a speed of at least 25 miles per hour or a speed consistent with the normal flow of traffic.

Wenger said that horse and buggies driven by Amish or

Mennonites were being stopped and fined by police for not using flashing lights on their buggies during daylight hours while on public roadways.

"Because of the very nature of horsedrawn vehicles and their limited use of public roadways, it is unnecessary to require the use of flashing lights on buggies during daylight hours," explained Wenger. However, the senator noted that buggies must continue using flashing lights during non-daylight hours.

Wenger said the bill now goes before the House of Representatives for consideration.

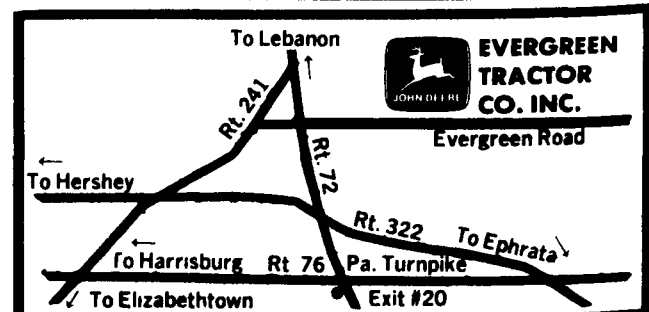
