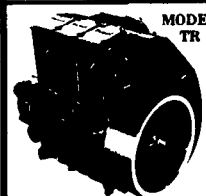


THE FRONT LINE IN DIESEL POWER

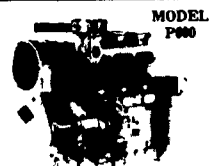
