

M.D. Farmer Receives Leadership Award

CENTREVILLE, Md. — Mark A. Sultenfuss, a soybean farmer from Centreville, Md., has been named by the Mid-Atlantic Soybean Association, the American Soybean Association (ASA) and Du Pont as the ASA/Lexone Young Leader for the Mid-Atlantic region — Delaware,

Maryland, New Jersey and Pennsylvania.

The fourth annual Young Leader Award honors farmers in 26 states who are leaders in their communities and on their farms. To be an award winner, a farmer must be willing to apply his leadership skills to providing direction to the

soybean industry.

The Mid-Atlantic Soybean Association participates in the leadership program to encourage young farm leaders to increase their involvement in the association. State winners in the program receive an expense-paid trip for two to the 1987 Soybean

EXPO in St. Louis this summer.

Mid-Atlantic winner Mark Sultenfuss and his wife Pam raise corn and soybeans in Queen Anne's County. In addition, Sultenfuss works for the University of Maryland Wye Research Center as assistant to the field crops manager. The center hosts scientists conducting research on major crops and serves as the seed processing facility for the Maryland Crop Improvement

Association.

Sultenfuss is vice president of Queen Anne's County Farm Bureau and treasurer of Queen Anne's County Forestry Board.

Sultenfuss sees as priorities for U.S. agriculture: Continued research to help farmers lower production costs; and an aggressive program to better market and distribute U.S. commodities worldwide.

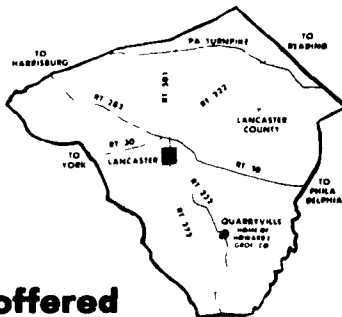
