**FEEDER CATTLE** IN VIRGINIA AUCTION AND THE MIDWEST MOVED STEADY TO \$5.00 HIGHER BEHIND AN IMPROVED SLAUGHTER CATTLE MARKET THAT MOVED STEADY TO \$4.00 HIGHER THE CARCASS BEEF MARKET MOVED \$1.00-5.00 HIGHER AS THE BOXED BEEF CUT-OUT VALUE REACHED \$110.12/CWT TUESDAY. THIS WAS \$6.88 HIGHER THAN LAST WEEK COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS AND THE MIDWEST WERE ALSO STRONGER AS COW BEEF WAS STEADY TO \$2.00 HIGHER BEEF PRODUCTIONS LAST WEEK WAS 2 PERCENT BELOW THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 11 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO

WHEN AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE 20 LBS HEAVIER. VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS HELD STEADY AS EAST COAST CARCASS PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 HIGHER. SLAUGHTER LAST WEEK WAS 4 PERCENT BELOW THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 18 PERCENT BELOW LAST YEAR AND AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE 4 LBS. LIGHTER. LAMBS PRICES IN VIRGINIA AND THE MIDWEST HELD STEADY ALONG WITH EAST COAST CARCASS PRICES. SLAUGHTER WAS UP 17 PERCENT FROM THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 21 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO AS DEMAND FOR EASTER SEASON CONTINUED. HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS AND THE MIDWEST WERE MIXED RANGING FROM \$2.00 LOWER TO \$2.25 HIGHER THIS WAS CAUSED BY AN UNSETTLE PORK PRODUCTS MARKET. LOINS AND BELLIES WERE STEADY TO AS MUCH AS \$4.00 HIGHER WHILE HAMS WERE UNEVENLY STEADY WITH OUTSIDE PRICE LEVELS \$10.50 HIGHER AND LOWER. PORK PRODUCTION LAST WEEK WAS 1 PERCENT ABOVE THE PREVIOUS WEEK, BUT 7 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO AND AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE ONLY 1 LB HEAVIER THE RICHMOND HOG MARKET CLOSED \$1.00-1.50 HIGHER THAN LAST WEDNESDAY WITH BARROWS AND GILTS 1-4, 220-250 LBS AT \$49 50-50 00/CWT.
