monitoring genetically engineered bacteria in nature and to detect the use or presence of biological warfare agents.

He said he did not start out to design a technique for environmental monitoring. Rather, he said, "We designed the technique because we were trying to find out what was happening in soil to some predator bacteria that we discovered."

Casida has been studying soil bacteria for more than 30 years. He is a recognized world leader in the field having discovered a

number of new types of bacteria including several that are extremely difficult to isolate for study in the laboratory.

He and his students, over the years, have developed techniques of thin-sectioning and frozen fracturing, now in wide use, that make it possible to use the electron microscope to study bacteria as they occur naturally in the soil without having to isolate and grow them in the laboratory.

Casida's work on the new bacterial monitoring technique was supported, in part, by a grant from the U.S. Army Research Office.

BST Adoption Rate Study

Requested By Dairy Commission

WASHINGTON — Realizing the potential impact bovine somatotropin could have on the dairy industry and the federal milk price support program, the National Commission on Dairy Policy has requested the Office of Technology Assessment to conduct a study on the rate of adoption by dairy farmers of BST.

In a letter to Dr. John Gibbons, Director of OTA, Clyde Rutherford, chairman of the Commission,

asked OTA, "What is the likely rate of adoption of BST by dairy farmers? What economic, social, or demographic forces will affect the rate of adoption? Will the price support level affect adoption? What will be the effect on small scale producers. How will consumers react? These are some of the questions that need answers if this commission is to carry out its requirements and achieve its goals."
