
During the month there were 119 herds with 6,699 cows processed in the DHIA program according to Alan P Kozak

In the owner sampler program there were 15 herds with 561 cows being processed. The herds ranged from a high of 63.2 pounds of milk, testing 3.1 percent fat, to a low of 26.3 pounds of milk, testing 3 3 percent fat
