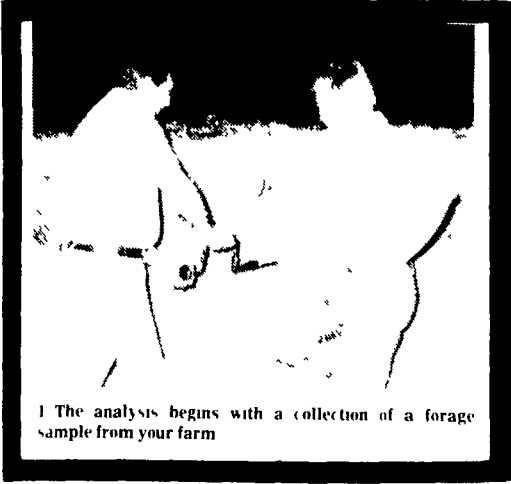


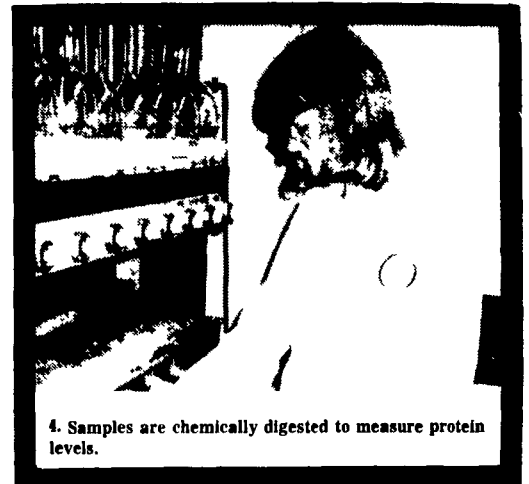

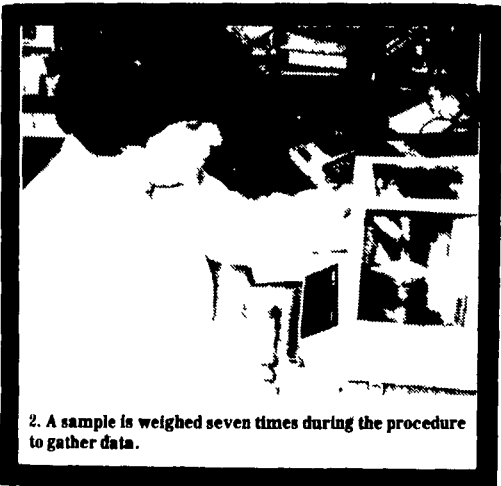


1. The analysis begins with a collection of a forage sample from your farm.

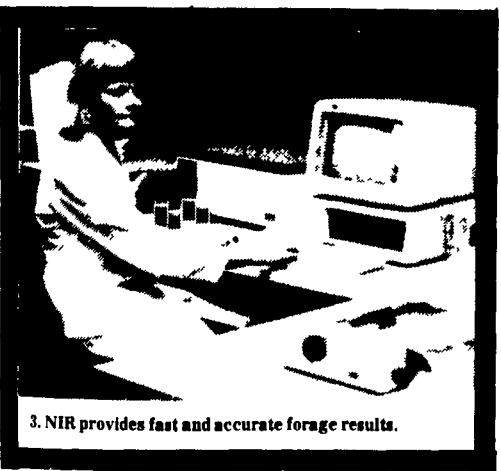

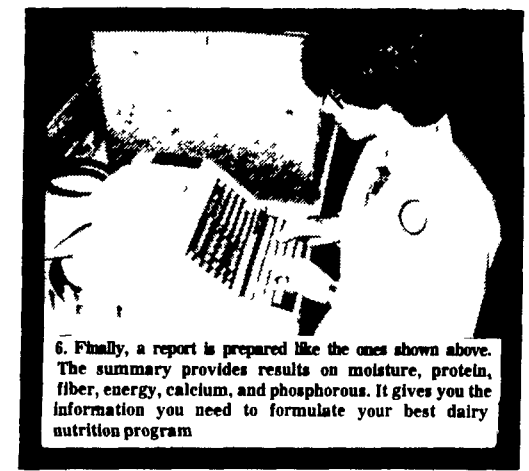
