LANCASTER — The Lancaster County Holstein Show will be held on July 23 at 10 a.m. at the Solanco Fairgrounds in Quarryville.

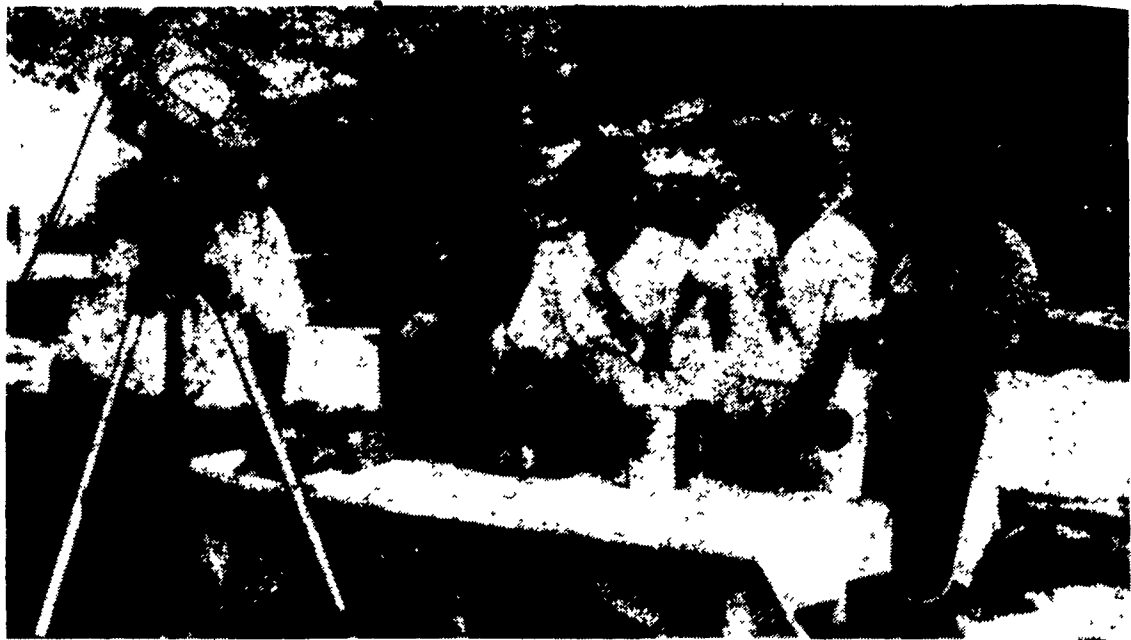
