MARTIC PRESERVATION **PUBLIC HEARING**

A public hearing will be held at the Fred and Evelyn Handel farm on Martic Heights Road, east of Nissley Lane, at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, June 30, 1987. The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comments on the acceptance of a permanent conservation easement by the Lancaster County Agricultural Preserve Board and the Lancaster County Conservancy. Friends of Agricultural Land Preservation, the Lancaster County Conservancy, and People for the Preservation of Martic Township (PPrOMPT) propose to cooperatively acquire a conservation easement which will preserve and protect the use and character of prime farmland on the 112 acre farm and protect woodland in its natural state. The Handels propose to donate a substantial portion of the value of the conservation easement.


