Potato Storage Down

HARRISBURG - Total stocks of potatoes stored in Pennsylvania on May 1 were 400,000 hundredweight, 34 percent less than last year. Of this amount, 56,000 cwt. or 14 percent was stored in processors facilities according to the Pennsylvania Agricultural Statistics Service.

Stocks are defined as the quantity remaining in storage for all purposes and uses, including shrinkage and waste and other losses that occur after the date of each report. Sales of fall potatoes for all purposes generally account for about 90 percent of the total fall production. Shrinkage, loss and home use account for the remaining 10 percent.
