COMMENT: TRADING WAS LIGHT TO FAIR, BUT BUYERS REMAINED RATHER SELECTIVE. CUTLETS WERE IRREGULAR, BUT THE BULK OF SALES WAS STILL NOTED AT CURRENT PRICE LEVELS. LINE-RUN BREASTS WERE SLIGHTLY MORE AVAILABLE, BUT GENERALLY HOLDING UNCHANGED AT 75 CENTS. RIB BREASTS WERE FULLY ADEQUATE WITH SOME LOTS BEING SOLD "OFF" LINE RUN VALUES. LEGS WERE FULLY ADEQUATE TO AMPLE, AND DISCOUNTING STILL PERSISTED IN A FEW QUARTERS. LEG QUARTERS WERE FULLY ADEQUATE BUT NOT FORCED TO THE SAME DEGREE AS LEGS. WINGS WERE BARELY ADEQUATE TO ADEQUATE, BUT DEMAND WAS STARTING TO SLOW DOWN IN MANY QUARTERS. BREASTS, SKINNED, BONELESS 1.65-1.70. RIB-ON-BREASTS .78-.79. LINE RUN BREASTS .75. LEGS 36-37. 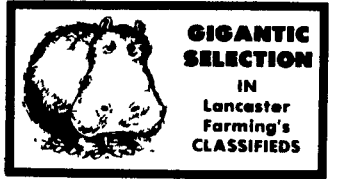
