The award, sponsored nationwide by DeKalb-Pfizer Genetics, is presented to the senior agriculture student attaining the highest degree of proficiency in scholarship, leadership and a supervised agricultural program.

Heisey attended Manheim Central High School where he was president of the local FFA chapter and sentinel of the Lancaster County FFA Chapter. His agricultural program consisted of work experience programs dealing with farm mechanics.

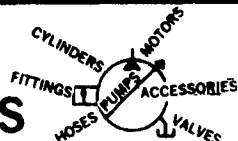
